As well, the skills of a seamstress are always in high demand in a country where the majority of shoppers will never buy “off the rack” in a department store. Another means of earning income is event decorating. Experts in each of these vocations will be coming to teach in our home in the coming months.

**COST:** \$4,000 to cover the purchase of materials for bee-keeping, sewing machines and cloth, and the materials for event decorating. The funds will also pay for the travel and time of our experts such as Juliet Frimps, the Ghanaian conservationist coming from Kakum National Park in Cape Coast to teach bee-keeping.
